Eligibility Overview

01 Meet the entry requirements for admission to a graduate program at Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU)

AND

02 Be enrolled in a bachelor's degree (i.e., a master's applicant) or a master's degree (i.e., a Ph.D. applicant) program at

■ A partner institution of TMU

OR

■ A higher education institution in either of the following locations

- any of Tokyo's sister cities
- any other Asian country or region

OR

Work in a research institution, governmental organization, or company in either of the following locations

- Any of Tokyo's sister cities
- Any other Asian country or region

AND

03 Demonstrate a commitment to collaboration and innovation for the enhancement of Tokyo and beyond.
